Our first year

- **Users:** Over 10,000 users who access the site through PC, Mac, and 5 mobile devices (iPad, iPhone, Kindle Fire and others).
- **Content Materials:** A total of 942 documents and 51 videos have been made available; 519 are fact/info sheets.
- **Collaborating institutions:** Over 50 collaborating institutions (government, university and non-government organizations).
- **Ask the expert:** Over 100 requests fully responded.
